Fieldwork (transportation to and from fieldwork site, travel, parking, housing, and meals)	Can be up to approximately \$4,000, depending on where the site is located and if the student must pay for airfare and double rent during fieldwork.
Cost of Living	Housing costs vary greatly around the Chicago area and are hard to predict, as it depends on the kind of neighborhood a student lives in and whether they have roommates. An information packet is provided about housing options and costs in a variety of neighborhoods.
