Bio & Objective

Dr. Sabrina Ali Jamal-Eddine, PhD BSN RN is an Arab disabled queer woman of color, spoken word poet, Registered Nurse, and health humanities nurse scientist. Sabrina completed her PhD in Nursing with an interdisciplinary certificate in Disability Ethics from University of Illinois Chicago (UIC). Sabrina's research explores the use of spoken word poetry as a form of critical narrative pedagogy to educate nursing students about disability, ableism, and disability justice. Sabrina is now a postdoc in UIC's Department of Disability and Human Development and a 2024 SFSU Longmore Institute Emerge Fellow. Sabrina served as a Summer Fellow at a residential National Endowment of the Humanities (NEH) Summer Institute at Arizona State University (2023), a Summer Fellow in Andrew W. Mellon's National Humanities Without Walls program at University of Michigan (2022), a Summer Research Fellow at UC Berkeley's Othering & Belonging Institute (2021), and an Illinois Leadership Education in Neurodevelopmental and related Disabilities (LEND) Trainee (2019-2020).

Sabrina's current goal is to create transformative change within healthcare education praxis by developing engaging anti-colonial pedagogic strategies rooted in the lived experiences of multiply marginalized disabled patients, scholars, artists, and activists. Sabrina's long-term goal is to found an applied public-humanities / community-engaged healthcare equity center in a university that confronts healthcare inequity, violence, and oppression and promotes liberation, humanization, and belongingness for all marginalized patients, students, and practitioners. Sabrina eventually hopes to pursue public office to advocate for healthcare equity and disability justice and to represent the underrepresented voices of nurses, Arab people, and disabled people alike.
