College of Applied Health Sciences Researcher of the Year Award

The purpose of the award is to honor a researcher who has demonstrated outstanding research achievements in their field of expertise over the past 3 years.

Criteria

While specific activities and evidence may vary among disciplines, nominees will be evaluated based upon the following criteria:

- 1. Has made significant advances to their field (i.e. innovation, discovery, or methodology).
- 2. Recognition by colleagues in national and/or international conferences or symposia as an invited keynote and/or plenary speaker.
- 3. Extramurally funded research support.
- 4. Publications in peer reviewed journals.
- 5. Research that has the potential to impact society.

Award

A one-time stipend of \$500 will be awarded to the recipient.

Eligibility

- 1. Associate or full professor, tenure or clinical track, with more than a 50% appointment in the college.
- 2. Individual has not received the award in the previous five years.

Nomination

- 1. One-two page nomination describing how the nominee's record meets the award criteria.
- 2. Nominee's cv.
- 3. Two peer evaluations addressing how the nominee's contribution meets the award criteria.
