

## UIC COVID-19 Campus Guidelines

The following is intended for UIC campus members who are **not** UI Health affiliates, **not** engaged in patient-facing clinical activities in the healthcare setting, and who are **not** engaged in research studies that require contact with research subjects.



### I have tested positive for COVID-19






#### **Obtaining Clearance from University Health Services**

- UIC employees testing positive for COVID-19, who were exposed to someone with COVID-19, or who have symptoms of COVID-19 will no longer be required to report to contact tracing and should follow departmental call-in procedures.
- All campus employees are required to receive clearance from UHS when their COVID absence exceeds 3 days. To receive clearance, employees have two options:
  - 1. Call (312) 996-7420 to schedule a virtual office visit with a Nurse Practitioner **OR**
  - 2. Go to the UHS clinic at 835 S. Wolcott Suite 144, Chicago, IL, 60612.



# I had close contact with someone who has COVID-19 or who is suspected of having COVID-19



- Quarantine is <u>not</u> recommended.
- Seek testing no sooner than 5 days after you were exposed.
- Wear a high-quality mask or respirator (e.g., KN95 or N95) anytime you are around others in your home or in public and in ALL SETTINGS ON UIC'S CAMPUS through day 10 from your last exposure date.
- Monitor yourself for symptoms of COVID-19 for 10 days from exposure.
  - If you develop symptoms, follow the guidance, below..

- Begin isolating immediately.
- Seek COVID-19 testing as soon as possible.
  - If you utilize a COVID-19 test and test negative, consider repeat testing 48 hours later.
- Reach out to contact tracing for tailored guidance and support.
