UIC co-authors are former MS students. Conducted user surveys to improve the assessment, which has been validated through psychometric research (2002 to 2015).
- First author on a chapter on the Environment and Human Occupation for the 5<sup>th</sup> edition of the Model of Human Occupation text (2017), the most widely used theory in the field of occupational therapy. Presented the new ecological environment-focused model at national and international conferences.
